Se la lettera non c'è, la scrive in un angolo del foglio in modo che non venga ripetuta e inizia il disegno dell'impiccato.

### **CHE COSA MANCA?**

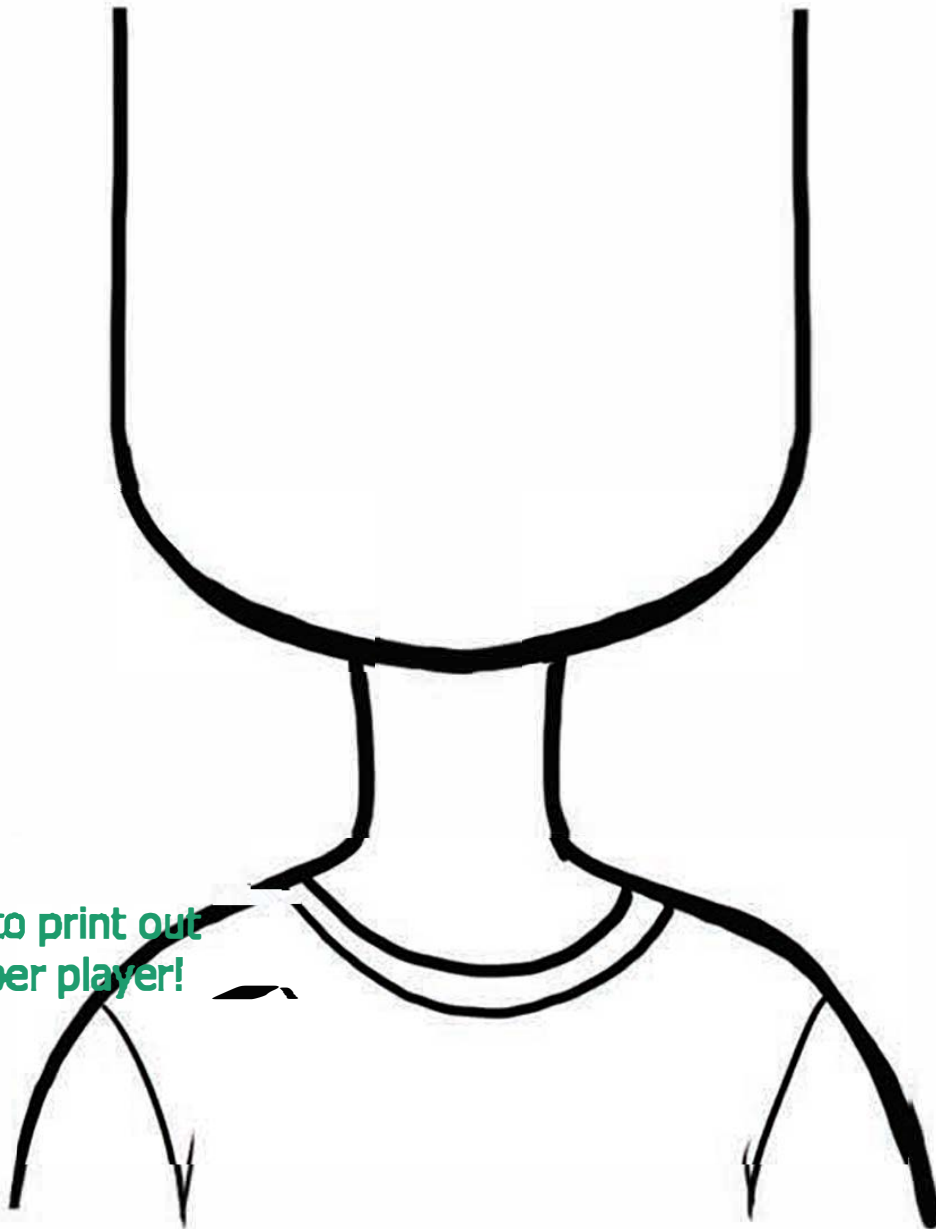

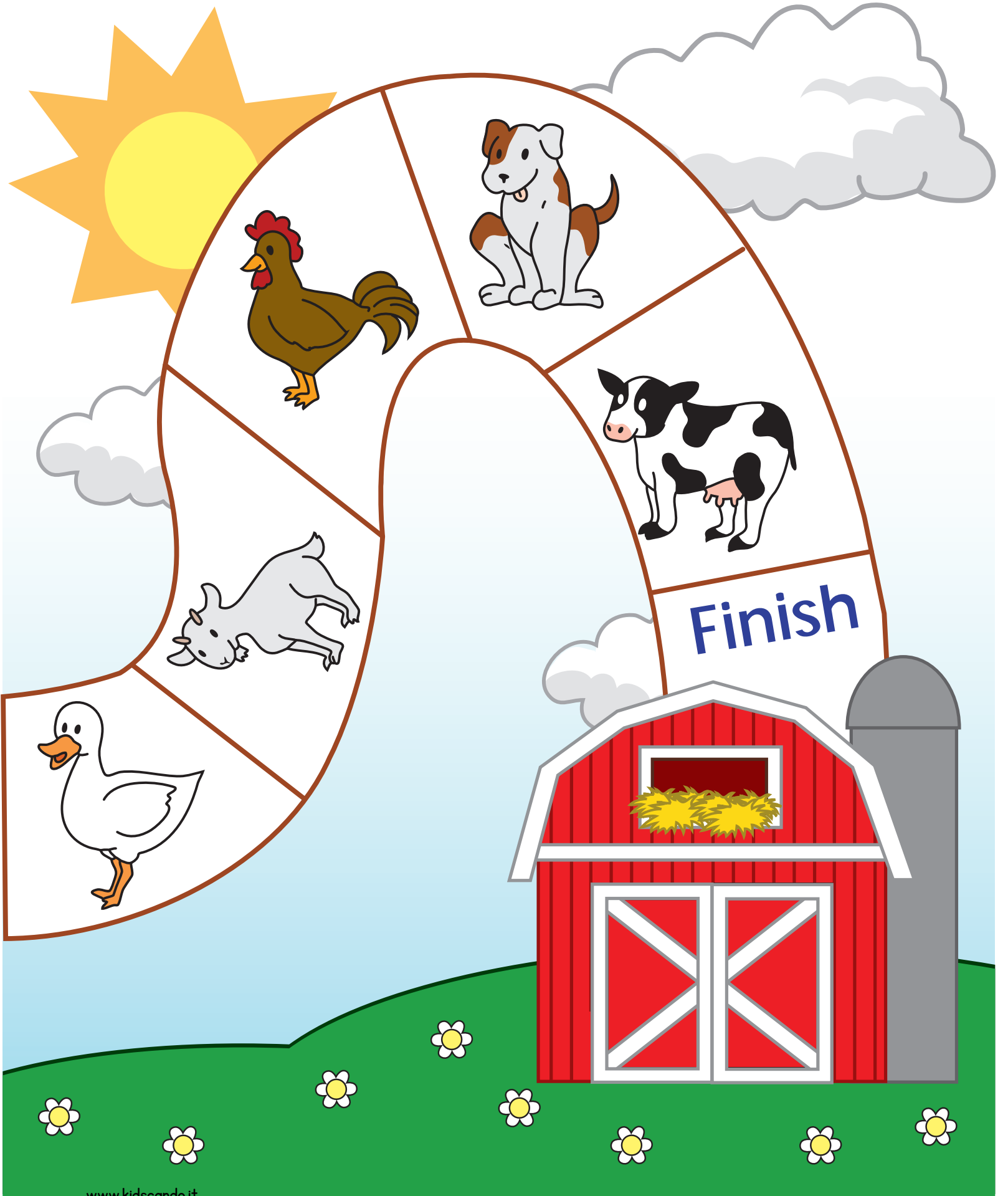
# Animal Round-Up

## You Will Need:

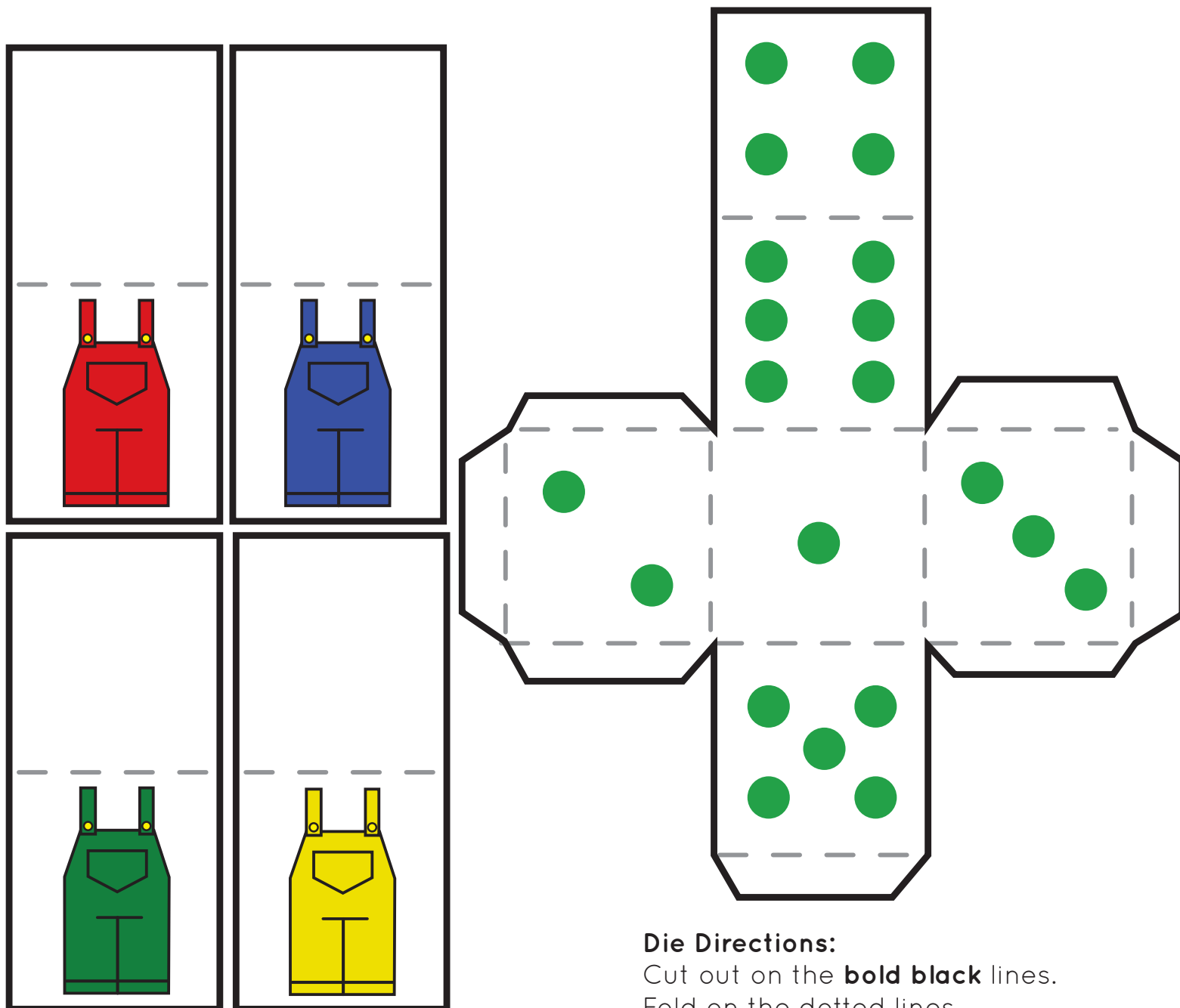
- Card Stock (or any thick paper)

Glue or tape the tabs.



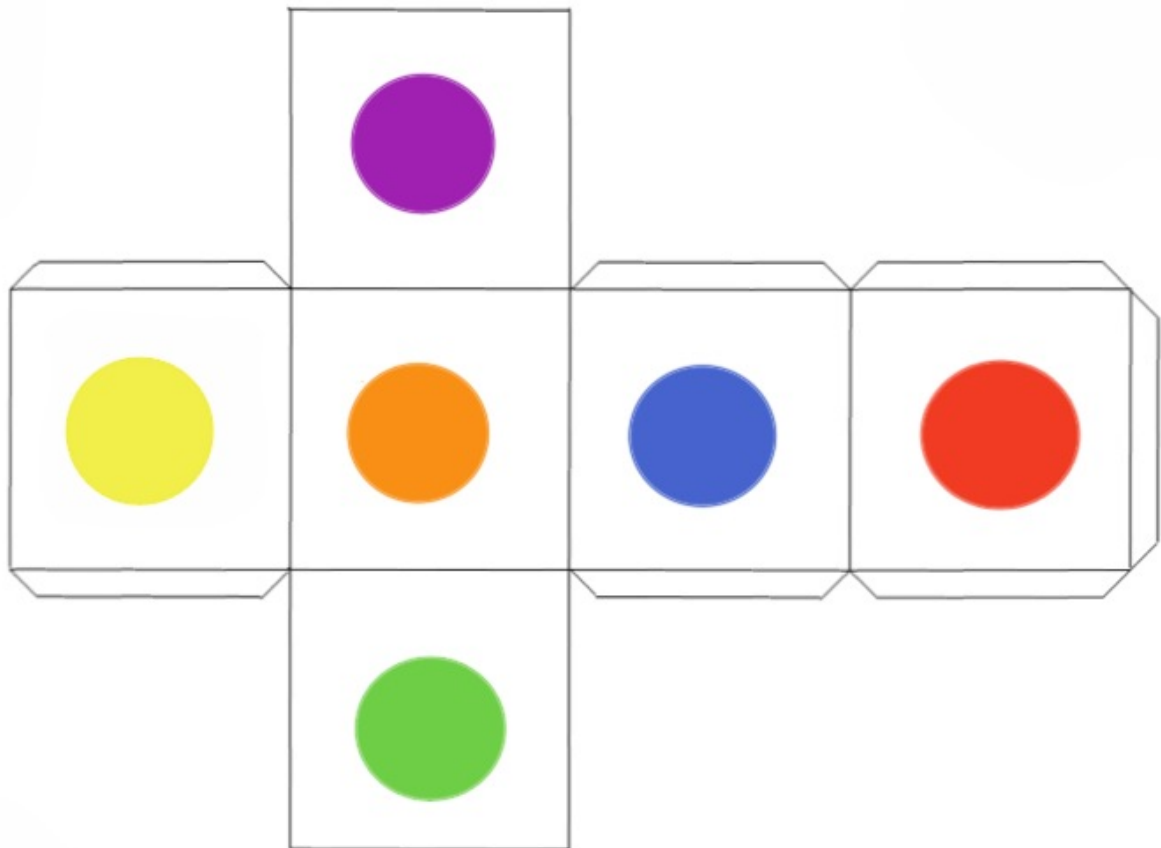
